The plot of this novel tells us about Harry's efforts to defeat a very evil wizard king named Lord Voldemort, who has ambitions to become an eternal and immortal, and wants to master all knowledges in the wizarding world to rule the whole world, and does no doubt to kill all people who want to stop him including Harry and his two themes. This book which consists of 17 chapters, describes how much Harry seriously becoming a great wizard with a high determination to defeat Lord Voldemort. In case also many fans to make a motivation, who are very vulnerable especially for the young people to the word "surrender"

In this novel, there are many problems that occured, therefore Harry's journey itself is not easy. In addition, Harry has an extraordinary natural ability to convince his friends with his speaking prowess, so many of his friends support him.

In Rowling's story as a novelist with Harry as the main character, Rowling herself

came across the idea of Harry by chance, during a crowded train journey from Manchester to London In 1990, Rowling was right on a crowded train. While he was on the train journey, suddenly the idea of Harry "fell into his head" it was described by Rowling on her website.

"I've been writing almost non-stop since I was six years old but I've never been so excited about an idea before. I just sat and thought, for four hours (waiting for the train cancelation), and all the details popped up in succession in my brain, and the skinny, black-haired, bespectacled boy who didn't realize that he was a wizard becoming more and more real for me"

The achievement in this series is the huge sales of around 450 million copies worldwide, and making it for the best-selling novel of all time. What's even more amazing is the novel adapted in 67 languages, then the next Harry Potter novel also received the best-selling award, In Indonesia. The first time this novel appeared was circulated by the Gramedia group with the publisher Gramedia Pustaka Utama. While the initial publishers were Bloomsbury in the United Kingdom and Scholastic Press in the United States.

There are 67 other countries that participated in publishing this novel, one of them in the Asian region, namely Japan, got the highest popularity. With its high popularity, this novel was also paid attention by several directors who wanted to adapt it into a film. Finally this novel was made into a film produced by Warner Bros. Pictures into eight film series. Not only films, but also Harry Potter became a popular merchandise trademark with a profit of \$15 billion. Rowling became the richest writer in literary history.

even according to the Harry Potter website, this Harry Potter theme was produced as a theme park for amusement parks such as The Wizarding World of Harry Potter in the Islands of Adventure, Universal Parks & Resorts and others, thus making Harry Potter a lot of fans around the world including Indonesia. Not satisfied with that, many fans want the author to continue the story until finally the author made a follow-up series. Finally the author, Rowling, granted the request of fans around the world by publishing several novels.

Each novel tells about one year of Harry's life, this novel is published every year from 1991-1998. The story of this novel also contains several flashbacks that have been passed to take lessons and make an idea which aims to defeat the enemy, Lord Voldemort.

The following is the background of the Harry Potter novel entitled Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone, from the background above we can understand some of the problems and benefits of this research

It is the combination of various elements that makes a novel tangible or conversely. If we read a novel, these elements are what we encounter. The elements in question are events, stories, plots, characterizations, themes, settings, storytelling points of view, language or language style, and so on. Extrinsic elements are elements that are outside the literary work. If the intrinsic element directly builds the story in a novel, the extrinsic element contributes to build the story in a novel indirectly

Knowledge of these two elements is very important to know because it is easy for

the readers to understand the plot in a story, as the author of this Harry Potter story said, namely Rowling quoted by the Harry Potter journal team, the main theme in the Harry Potter series is death: "My book mostly about death. It opens with the death of Harry's parents. Voldemort's obsession with conquering death and finding immortality at any cost is the goal of every person with magical abilities. I understand why Voldemort wants to defeat death. We are all afraid of this.

That Knowledge of this plot is very useful for the reader because it will become a motivation for the reader, as In the Slate article dated November 8, 2002, Chris Suellentrop said that Potter was "the poor boy who did well in school because of the talents of his friends and relatives". He notes that in Rowling's fiction, magical abilities are "something you are born with, not something that can be attained", Suellentrop also states that Dumbledore's adage: "It is our choices, that show what kind of person we are, more than our abilities", namely hypocritical. On August 12, 2007, the New York Times reviewed the Deathly Hallows, Christopher Hitchens praised Rowling for her "English school story" without creating a "world of diverse democracy"

From the plot that we already know that there are many benefits in understanding a story plot such as in the novel Harry Potter and The Philosopher's Stone – JK Rowling (1997), there is a motivation, mystery, and excitement of the story presented as we know there are several motivations. in the novel one of the most famous motivations is "about don't forget to be happy"

You certainly know the character of Professor Dumbledore in the Harry Potter saga. The head of the Hogwarts school of magic is indeed described as a smart, wise, and respected figure. Almost all of the inspirational quotes in the Harry Potter story are quotes from this male character with the full name of Albus Percival Wulfric Brian Dumbledore.

One of the quotes is Happiness can be found even in the darkest of times, if one only remembers to turn on the light. Dumbledore delivered those words in his address to all the students in Harry Potter's fourth year joining Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry. The meaning of Dumbledore's sentence if we apply it in life is so that we never forget to be happy, even in the most difficult conditions

Another motivation contained in this novel, namely "Don't hesitate to defend the weak"

there is a story where some students practice broomsticks, but the exercise doesn't go smoothly because Harry's best friend, Naville, has a damaged broom. long story short the teacher took naville to the hospital, then malfoy took naville's broom and wanted to throw it away, however, suddenly tiva harry immediately took it and did not want malfoy to oppress naville

in this lesson we learned that life must help, and don't hesitate to defend the weak,

so for that incident we were finally chosen to be the seeker for the Gryffindor House Quidditch team, which in general, first year students can't get into the team.

Therefore, it is important for us to understand a plot so that we can know the message, morals and motivations contained in this novel

Plot Novel Harry Potter and The Philosopher's Stone – J.K Rowling (1997)

Harry Potter is a child who was adopted by his father's family, namely his uncle named Dursley in Surrey. Until he grew up he was cared for by his uncle, and when he was eleventh birthday, Harry met and was told by a strange and mysterious person he was Rubeus Hagrid, that he had the blood of a wizard, he was a phenomenal wizard in the wizarding world. because he could survive the onslaught of lord Voldemort's attack, a very evil demon king, in fact Voldemort was a magician who killed Harry's biological parents, and Harry survived the attack of lord Voldemort and only left a lightning scar on Harry's forehead and killed Voldemort,

Then long story short Hagrid invited Harry to attend Hogwarts, a magic school, after buying some school supplies Harry set off via platform 9 in a secret place in Cross Station King.

In the train Harry met Ronald Weasley and Hermione Granger, he was a child of the original wizard, and upon arrival at school Harry and all the early grade students at Hogwarts School, were divided into four boarding groups, namely Gryffindor, Hufflepuff, Ravenclaw and Slytherin. But at school, they are already familiar with a group called Slytherin, this group is a black magic group, because Harry already knows about this group of evil wizards, Harry managed to convince a magical selection hat to be placed in the Gryffindor group along with Ron and Hermione.

Then long story short Harry started to join the Gryffindor team and began to learn magic at this school and also found some info about his parents, then Together with the Gryffindor team he took part in his first competition, Quidditch (a race using a broomstick) and became a Seeker. He also finally finds out that his parents are Seekers.

One day, Harry's friends even found a strange animal, namely a giant three-headed dog in the forbidden corridor on the third floor of the school, while Harry was lucky to escape from the giant in a quidditch match. They assumed that someone was trying to get past the dog. Harry finds the Mirror of Eternity which can show the desires of a person's heart. Headmaster Albus Dumbledore removed the mirror and advised Harry not to look for it again. Using information from Hagrid accidentally uttering it, Hermione discovers that the dog is guarding the Philosopher's Stone, a stone that can be used to grant eternal life to its owner. Harry deduces that his potions teacher, Severus Snape, is trying to get hold of the stone. Harry was caught when he came out of the dormitory at night and he was taken into custody. While

helping Hagrid in a dark forest, he sees a hooded figure drinking unicorn blood for healing. Harry deduces that the hooded figure is Voldemort and he also deduces that Snape is trying to obtain the enchanted stone to restore Voldemort to full power.

After hearing Hagrid's words that the giant animal will fall asleep if music is played and who is free to talk about it then Harry's friend concludes that Snape is a person at the bar, after knowing that person Snape left for some business and Harry's friends also aim to steal the rock at night before Snape found it first

But when they were about to take the stone they encountered many obstacles such as: a poisonous and deadly plant, a chess match with a chess he was the size of a human, these three people used their skills to overcome various obstacles, namely Hermione used her knowledge of spells to get past the plant, Harry used skills as a Seeker to get the flying key, and Ron uses his chess skills to win a chess match. However, Ron was almost killed in the match and Hermione and Ron stayed at the match venue while Harry made his way to the next room but they finally managed to overcome some of those obstacles,

Then they arrived in the last room, Harry discovered the fact that Snape was not the one who wanted the stone but his teacher, Professor Quirell, Quirell revealed that he freed the troll and tried to kill Harry in a Quidditch match, he also revealed that Snape had been protecting Harry all this time. and friends and tried to stop it, then Harry found the stone in his pocket after looking at it near the tarsah mirror, when Quirell wanted to catch Harry in order to get an answer from Harry about what object he saw in the mirror, then Quirell opened his secret by opening his turban and it turns out that there is Lord Voldemort living in the back of his head, seeing that Harry tries to escape but the professor shoots fire with just a snap of a finger, Harry is trapped then Voldemort tries to convince Harry to give the stone and promises that his parents are about to come back to life, but Harry refuses, then Quirell is really angry and wants to kill Harry which causes the stairs to become dust, a fierce fight occurs Quirell tries to take the stone but Harry holds and grips his face, so Quirell turns to dust and dies, but Voldemort's spirit passed through Harry and knocked Harry unconscious

The next day Harry woke up in his school hospital with Professor Dumbledore by his side. Dumbledore explains that the stone has been destroyed, and also informs that Hermione and Ron are fine. Quirell burns when he touches Harry, when Harry's mother died saving him, her death gave Harry a power, namely the power of love to protect Harry from Voldemort. At the year-end party, Dumbledore awarded last-minute boarding points to Harry, Ron, Hermione, and Neville for their bravery and intelligence, earning Gryffindor the House Cup. Before Harry and the rest of the students left Hogwarts for summer vacation, Harry realized when it was time to go home, that Hogwarts was his real home.

Learning

Before we dive into understanding the relevant science behind the learning process, let's ground ourselves in a definition of learning that is drawn from research. Learning is a process that: 1. Is active - process of engaging and manipulating objects, experiences, and conversations in order to build mental models of the world (Dewey, 1938; Piaget, 1964; Vygotsky, 1986). Learners build knowledge as they explore the world around them, observe and interact with phenomena, converse and engage with others, and make connections between new ideas and prior understandings. 2. Builds on prior knowledge - and involves enriching, building on, and changing existing understanding, where "one's knowledge base is a scaffold that supports the construction of all future learning" (Alexander, 1996, p. 89). 3. occurs in a complex social environment - and thus should not be limited being examined or perceived as something that happens on an individual level. Instead, it is necessary to think of learning as a social activity involving people, the things they use, the words they speak, the cultural context they're in, and the actions they take (Bransford, et al., 2006; Rogoff, 1998), and that knowledge is built by members in the activity (Scardamalia & Bereiter, 2006). 4. Is situated in an authentic context - provides learners with the opportunity to engage with specific ideas and concepts on a need-to-know or want-to-know basis (Greeno, 2006; Kolodner, 2006). 5. requires learners' motivation and cognitive engagement to be sustained when learning complex ideas considerable mental effort and persistence are necessary.

The conditions to learning are clear to input, but the process is incomplete without making sense of what outputs constitute learning has taken place. At the core, learning is a process that results in a change in knowledge or behavior as a result of experience. Understanding what it takes to get that knowledge in and out (or promote behavioral change of a specific kind) can help optimizing.
