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ABSTRACT

This research aims to describe in depth several aspects of grammatical and lexical devices contained in the October 2023 edition of the Ketikpos.com news discourse, to indicate the dominant aspects of grammatical devices and lexical device aspects, and to indicate the types of devices whose appearance has excellent intensity in Ketikpos news discourse—.com October 2023 edition. Data analysis in this research used the magic method. This method describes several aspects of grammatical and lexical devices in the Ketikpos.com news discourse, October 2023 edition. Furthermore, this method can also identify the dominant aspects of grammatical and lexical devices and the types of devices used. Its appearance is intense in the Ketikpos.com news discourse, October 2023 edition. The approach used in this research is microstructural. The microstructural approach is an approach that examines discourse based on aspects of form and aspects of meaning. The form aspect is the birth structure of language, which includes grammatical aspects. The meaning aspect is the inner structure of language, which includes the lexical aspect.

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INTRODUCTION

In discourse, the critical part is the integrity or completeness of its meaning. The meaning, content and message in a discourse should be complete. What is meant by complete in this context is that in a discourse, there are complete concepts, ideas, and thoughts that the reader or listener can understand. Discourse is the highest or greatest because discourse is formed from sentences that meet grammatical and other discursive requirements, namely cohesion and coherence. Cohesion is the harmonious relationship between elements contained in discourse. Furthermore, cohesive discourse can create coherent discourse, namely discourse that is neat and correct.

Discourse has the meaning of the complete language unit expressed orally, such as news, speeches, lectures, sermons and dialogues or in writing, such as short stories, novels, books, letters and other written documents which, seen from its birth structure (in terms of form), is cohesive, interrelated and from its inner structure (in terms of meaning) it is coherent (integrated). Discourse analysis aims to achieve equal perception between writers and readers. In discourse analysis, sociolinguistic patterns are often used, namely understanding a text, in this case, a short story, by involving context and situation to arrive at the meaning/message/idea desired by the writer.

Discourse analysis, especially in journalistic (media) discourse, is the "highlighting" of the author's ideology which takes precedence in the discourse. Hence, it needs to be described in more detail so that readers can understand the author's intentions. A discourse with cohesion and coherence can be analyzed by considering its grammatical and lexical content.

LITERATURE REVIEW

Previous Related Study

First, Sumarlam (2003) conducted research with the title Analysis of Javanese Poetry "Jaka Ijo and Tresnawulan" by N. Sakdani Review from the Cultural Contexts and Situation as well as Grammatical and Lexical Aspects. Through this research, the analysis of poetic discourse in terms of cultural context is the basis for holistically understanding the meaning of discourse. Based on the analysis of the context of the situation, there are physical, epistemic and social contexts considered from various interpretations (personal, temporal and locational), as well as the principle of analogy. The grammatical aspects used by the author in the poems Jaka Ijo and Tresnawulan include (1) references, persona, demonstrative, and comparative, (2) substitution, (3) ellipsis, and (4) conjunction. The lexical aspects used by the author are repetition, synonymy, collocation, hyponymy, antonymy and equivalence.

Second, Muljani (2003) conducted research entitled "Bank Muamalat" Advertising Discourse in Sabili Magazine: Microstructural and Macrosstructural Approaches. The results of Muljani's research reveal that the advertising discourse of "Bank Muamalat" uses several references, namely demonstrative, endophoric-anaphoric, and persona. The lexical cohesion found in advertisements includes repetition, antonyms and omissions. Based on discourse analysis using a macrostructural approach, it was revealed that Bank Muamalat's advertisements did not introduce or describe new service products but were already at the stage of persuading readers to become customers and not move to another bank. Socially and culturally, the advertisement writer tries to remind customers and potential customers that Bank Muamalat has experience as a foreign exchange bank and Bank Muamalat is the first Sharia bank in Indonesia as a foreign exchange bank.

Third, Tarwiyah (2003) conducted research titled Discourse Aspects of M. Cholil Bisri's Column in Suara Merdeka Daily. This research revealed that Column M. Cholil Bisri is a form of the author's feedback on the social reality that occurred and is the result of reflection on that reality. M. Cholil Bisri's columns pay attention to the situational and socio-cultural contexts. The creation process is influenced by the author's role as a scholar and intellectual who often conveys moral messages through his columns. This text has instrumental, regulatory, and representational functions. In expressing these functions, the author uses a lot of attitudinal lexis, namely lexis, which implies the author's opinion, feeling, and attitude towards the reality being described or expressed.

Variable

Kridalaksana (2013:179) defines discourse as the most complete unit of language; in the grammatical hierarchy, it is the highest or largest grammatical unit. According to Kridalaksana, discourse is realized in complete essays, namely short stories, novels, books, encyclopedia series, etc. A concept that is not much different from that put forward by Kridalaksana is the concept of discourse based on the Big Indonesian Dictionary (2016: 1005), namely that discourse is the complete unit of language, and its realization appears in the form of a complete essay, such as a novel, book or article. Meanwhile, discourse analysis is a branch of linguistics developed to analyze language units larger than sentences. The unit in question can be a paragraph, reading text, invitation, conversation, short story, and so on (Kartomihardjo, 2013, p. 21).

Microstructural studies include grammatical and lexical aspects. Sumarlam (2003:23—34) explains several grammatical aspects of discourse, which include (1) reference, (2) substitution, (3) ellipsis, and (4) conjunction. Meanwhile, lexical discourse can be divided into six types, namely (1) repetition (repetition), (2) synonymy (similar words), (3) collocation (opposite words), (4) hyponymy (topdown relationship), (5) antonymy (opposite words), and (6) equivalence (equivalence).

METHOD

Design and Samples

This research is included in qualitative research, which is descriptive analysis which provides an objective picture by describing the messages and elements of external discourse in the October 2023 Edition of Ketikpos.com News Discourse. The approach used is discourse analysis. Discourse analysis studies message structure or various language functions (pragmatics). The method used in this research is discourse analysis, while the research approach uses a microstructural approach which examines discourse based on aspects of form and aspects of meaning.

Instrument and Procedure

In analyzing this discourse, researchers used the magic method. This high method describes several aspects of grammatical and lexical devices in the Ketikpos.com news discourse, October 2023 edition.

From the existing data, the analysis procedure to be carried out is as follows.

- 1) Read news discourse on Ketikpos.com to get a first impression. Then, reread it to gain an understanding of the content of the discourse. In this first step, the researcher carefully read the news discourse on the online media Ketikpos.com. Careful and repeated reading to gain a deep understanding of the content of the discourse.
- 2) Characterize every language phenomenon contained in the Ketikpos.com news discourse by carrying out coding activities for every language phenomenon that appears, both from the grammatical and lexical aspects.
- 3) Identify grammatical and lexical aspects in the Ketikpos.com news discourse, October 2023 edition.
- 4) I am classifying language phenomena contained in Ketikpos.com discourse into two groups: grammatical and lexical aspects.
- 5) We are analyzing the grammatical and lexical aspects of the Ketikpos.com news discourse, October 2023 edition.
- 6) Describe the grammatical and lexical aspects of the Ketikpos.com news discourse, October 2023 edition.
- 7) Prepare analytical conclusions regarding each language phenomenon that appears in the Ketikpos.com news discourse, October 2023 edition.

Design and Samples

Data analysis was carried out using the high method in this research. The high method is used in research to analyze things in the structure of language, in this case, several aspects of grammatical and lexical devices contained in news discourse in the Ketikpos.com news, October 2023 edition.
